- 6.8 cross Water St. to Woodchuck Hill Rd.
- 8.3 L over bridge, straight up hill, to Hanover Rd.
- 10.1 L Cemetery Rd.
- 11.0 R Rte. 97 N.
- 11.8 R Rte. 14 E.
